The Event

A public ceremony for the unveiling of a memorial bronze plaque to mark an important event in the history of Quinte West. In 1942, in the midst of the Second World War, the Central Bridge Company received a contract from the Royal Navy to build steel hulled ocean-going tugboats. Built two miles up the Trent River, these 65-foot tugboats were launched at the site of this monument to begin their journey to Europe. The boat-building methods developed in Trenton came to be used worldwide. The memorial plaque will highlight this aspect of the community's rich history for Quinte West residents and visitors.

By the Trent River, at Kiwanis Riverside Park near the Trenton Rowing and Paddling Club boathouse, Ontario Street, Quinte West.
